- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of State Health Services
- 6 shall conduct a study on establishing testing and scientific

- 8 (b) The study conducted under this section must:
- 9 (1) evaluate available and emerging methods of testing
- 10 for tetrahydrocannabinol intoxication;
- 11 (2) evaluate the establishment of a scientifically
- 12 valid threshold for intoxication, comparable to the standards
- 13 applicable to blood alcohol content, for use in the prosecution of
- 14 offenses under Chapter 49, Penal Code, legal proceedings
- 15 determining criminal or civil liability, and workplace safety
- 16 standards, policies, and regulations; and
- 17 (3) create legislative recommendations based on the
- 18 findings under Subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection.
- 19 (c) Not later than October 1, 2026, the Department of State
- 20 Health Services shall submit a report on the study conducted under
- 21 this section, including any legislative recommendations, to the
- 22 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 23 representatives, and presiding officer of each standing
