A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to flood safety requirements for youth camps located near
3	rivers, creeks, and streams.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 141, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 141.0091 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 141.0091. FLOOD SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN YOUTH
8	CAMPS. (a) This section applies only to a youth camp located near a
9	river, creek, or stream.
10	(b) A youth camp operator of a youth camp to which this
11	section applies shall for each camp cabin used as an overnight
12	accommodation for campers:
13	(1) equip the cabin with emergency equipment,
14	<pre>including:</pre>
15	(A) radio devices capable of cabin-to-cabin
16	<pre>communication;</pre>
17	(B) reflective life jackets suitable for the age
18	of each camper staying in the cabin in a number equal to:
19	(i) the maximum occupancy of the cabin; or
20	(ii) the total number of campers assigned
21	to the cabin, provided the camp distributes a life jacket to each
22	camper at the time of the camper's arrival at camp;
23	(C) a first aid kit; and
24	(D) an emergency hammer tool suitable for

- 1 breaking a window;
- 2 (2) safely store in the cabin in a location easily
- 3 accessible to campers and other cabin occupants the emergency
- 4 equipment described by Subdivision (1); and
- 5 (3) conspicuously post in the cabin easily
- 6 understandable instructions for using the emergency equipment
- 7 <u>described by Subdivision (1).</u>
- 8 <u>(c) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary</u>
- 9 to implement this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 15 legislative session.
