- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 418, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 418.1103 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.1103. LOCAL EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEM. (a) In this
- 8 section, "contact information" means an individual's telephone
- 9 <u>number</u>, mobile telephone number, physical address, or e-mail
- 10 address.

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- 11 (b) For purposes of operating an emergency warning system
- 12 for residents of a political subdivision, the political subdivision
- 13 may contract with the department for the department's disclosure of
- 14 the contact information of a political subdivision resident who
- 15 consents to the disclosure for the purpose of participating in the
- 16 <u>system.</u>
- 17 (c) A participant in an emergency warning system described
- 18 by Subsection (b) may request removal from the system by submitting
- 19 to the applicable political subdivision a written request,
- 20 including a text message from a cellular telephone or other
- 21 wireless communication device, for removal. On receipt of the
- 22 request, the applicable political subdivision shall remove the
- 23 participant's contact information from the system and cease issuing
- 24 emergency warnings to the former participant through the system.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 2 is amended by adding Section 521.016 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 521.016. VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL EMERGENCY
- 4 WARNING SYSTEM. (a) In this section, "contact information" has the
- 5 meaning assigned by Section 418.1103, Government Code.
- 6 (b) When a person applies for an original or renewal
- 7 driver's license under this chapter, the person may consent to:
- 8 <u>(1) participate in an emergency warning system</u>
- 9 described by Section 418.1103, Government Code; and
- 10 (2) the department's disclosure of the person's
- 11 contact information to the municipality or county, or both, in
- 12 which the person resides for the purpose of participating in an
- 13 emergency warning system the municipality or county operates.
- 14 (c) The department shall include space on each application
- 15 for an original or renewal driver's license that allows a person
- 16 applying for an original or renewal driver's license to indicate
- 17 whether the person consents to participate in an emergency warning
- 18 system operated by the municipality or county, or both, in which the
- 19 person resides and consents to the department's disclosure of the
- 20 person's contact information to the municipality or county or both.
- 21 <u>(d) The department shall disclose a person's contact</u>
- 22 <u>information to a municipality or county for participation in an</u>
- 23 emergency warning system if:
- 24 (1) the person indicates the person's consent to
- 25 participate in an emergency warning system and to the disclosure of
- 26 the person's contact information under Subsection (b); and
- 27 (2) the applicable municipality or county:

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1	(A) operates an emergency warning system; and
2	(B) has contracted with the department for the
3	disclosure of the person's contact information under Section
4	418.1103, Government Code.
5	(e) Contact information a municipality or county obtains
6	under this section may not be used or disclosed for any purpose
7	other than enrolling a person in an emergency warning system and
8	issuing warnings to the person through the system.
9	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the

10 last day of the legislative session.
