- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Water Development Board regarding
- 3 standards for placement of recreational vehicles and temporary

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Board" means the Texas Water Development Board.
- 8 (2) "Flood hazard area" means an area of land
- 9 designated as a flood hazard area by the Federal Emergency
- 10 Management Agency under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968
- 11 (42 U.S.C. Section 4001 et seq.).
- 12 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The board shall conduct a study to
- 13 assess the need for standards related to the placement of
- 14 recreational vehicles and any temporary dwelling structures that
- 15 are or will be permanently or temporarily located in a flood hazard
- 16 area.
- 17 (b) The board may consult with the Federal Emergency
- 18 Management Agency and any other federal or state agency for the
- 19 purpose of collecting information necessary to conduct the study
- 20 required by Subsection (a) of this section.
- 21 SECTION 3. REPORT AND LEGISLATIVE RECOMMENDATIONS. (a)
- 22 Not later than January 1, 2027, the board shall submit to the
- 23 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 24 representatives, and each other member of the legislature a report

- 1 on the findings of the study required by this Act.
- 2 (b) The report must include recommendations for legislation
- 3 to address the findings of the study.
- 4 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires February 1, 2027.
- 5 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the
- 6 91st day after the last day of the legislative session.
