- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter L, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 5.517 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 5.517. EMERGENCY OR TEMPORARY ORDER CONCERNING DEBRIS
- 9 DISPOSAL AFTER WEATHER EMERGENCY. (a) On request of the county
- 10 judge of a county, the commission may issue an emergency or
- 11 temporary order under this subchapter concerning solid waste
- 12 disposal or management or controlled outdoor burning of debris
- 13 following a weather emergency in the county regardless of whether a
- 14 state of disaster or state of emergency has been declared under
- 15 state or federal law.
- 16 (b) The commission shall respond to a request for an
- 17 emergency or temporary order described by Subsection (a) as soon as
- 18 practicable after the commission receives the request.
- (c) Section 5.502 does not apply to a request submitted
- 20 <u>under this</u> section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 5.517, Water Code, as added by this Act,
- 22 applies to a weather emergency occurring before, on, or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
