A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to creation of the Screwworm Abatement Trust (SWAT) Fund.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 403.111 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 403.111. SCREWWORM ABATEMENT TRUST FUND. (a) The
7	Screwworm Abatement Trust Fund is established as a trust fund
8	outside the state treasury with the comptroller as trustee.
9	(b) The trust fund is established to provide a fund from
10	which the comptroller as trustee may support activities related to
11	the prevention, control, and eradication of the New World
12	Screwworm.
13	(c) The trust fund consists of money gifted, granted,
14	donated, or appropriated for deposit to the credit of the trust fund
15	and any interest or other earnings attributable to the trust fund.
16	The comptroller shall hold money credited to the trust fund for use
17	only for screwworm prevention, control, or eradication efforts and
18	expenses incurred in administering the trust fund. The balance of
19	the trust fund may not exceed \$50 million at any time. The
20	comptroller may establish in the trust fund one or more accounts to
21	administer money designated for a particular screwworm-related
22	purpose for which money has been credited to the trust fund.
23	(d) The comptroller may distribute money from the trust fund

to support screwworm-related programs, research, surveillance, and

- 1 emergency response activities carried out by public agencies,
- 2 institutions of higher education, or other governmental entities.
- 3 (e) The comptroller may coordinate with local, state,
- 4 federal, and interstate agencies or institutions to ensure the
- 5 effective use of trust fund resources for intergovernmental
- 6 screwworm abatement efforts.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
