- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1.006, Election Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1.006. EFFECT OF WEEKEND, [OR] HOLIDAY, OR FORCE
- 7 MAJEURE.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1.006, Election Code, is amended by
- 9 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 (a) If the last day for performance of an act is a Saturday,
- 12 Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, or the performance of
- 13 the act is not possible because of an act of God, force majeure, or
- 14 similar cause beyond the control of the person performing the act,
- 15 the act is timely if performed on the next regular business day,
- 16 except as otherwise provided by this code.
- 17 (g) For a statewide election or an election with territory
- 18 <u>located in more than one county, the secretary of state shall make</u>
- 19 the determination whether an event qualifies as a force majeure.
- 20 For an election that covers territory located wholly within one
- 21 county, the county judge shall make the determination described by
- 22 this subsection.
- SECTION 3. Section 1.007, Election Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

- 1 (c-1) If a delivery, submission, or filing under this code
- 2 requires submission in person by a specific time, the delivery,
- 3 submission, or filing shall be accepted if the person or document
- 4 entered the office before the prescribed deadline.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 6 last day of the legislative session.
