A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the repeal of
- 2 the Dementia Prevention and Research Institute of Texas and the
- 3 Dementia Prevention and Research Fund to provide money for research

- 5 Parkinson's disease, and related disorders in this state, and

- 8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 9 SECTION 1. Article III, Section 68, Texas Constitution, is 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 2. The comptroller shall transfer any money
- 12 appropriated or transferred to the Dementia Prevention and Research
- 13 Fund to the Texas Education Agency to reduce the state compression
- 14 percentage under Section 48.255, Education Code, to the lowest
- 15 possible percentage.
- 16 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 20 repeal of the Dementia Prevention and Research Institute of Texas
- 21 and the Dementia Prevention and Research Fund to provide money for
- 22 research on and prevention and treatment of dementia, Alzheimer's
- 23 disease, Parkinson's disease, and related disorders in this state,
- 24 and transferring from that fund \$3 billion to Texas Education
