WHEREAS, Corpus Christi native Justin Lamkin of Texas A&M
University was selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 2025 Major
League Baseball Draft; and

WHEREAS, The Royals used the 71st overall pick to take Mr. Lamkin in the second round of the MLB Draft, which was held on July 13 and 14 in Cumberland, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, The son of Jeff and Julie Lamkin, Mr. Lamkin first 7 gained acclaim at Calallen High School in Corpus Christi, where he 8 was ranked as the No. 5 left-handed pitcher in the Lone Star State; 9 Texas A&M signed him to its 2022 recruiting class, and as a true 10 11 freshman, he took the mound as a starter and reliever, tallying a 12 3-3 record and one save; after an exceptional performance in the postseason, he was named to the 2023 Southeastern Conference 13 14 All-Tournament Team; continuing to excel in his sophomore season, he helped lead the Aggies to the College World Series, where he 15 16 allowed just three runs in 10.2 innings; in 2025, he turned in his strongest year yet, finishing with a 3.42 ERA and a team-best 98 17 18 strikeouts; and

WHEREAS, The highlight of Mr. Lamkin's college career came in May 2025 against Georgia when he tossed his first complete-game shutout, striking out a career-high 15 batters and limiting the Bulldogs to only three hits; as a result, he was named the National Pitcher of the Week by the College Baseball Foundation, the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, and Perfect

1 Game; he was also chosen as the SEC Pitcher of the Week, his second 2 time to earn the honor; in March 2025, he became the 22nd member of 3 the 200-K Club at Texas A&M; and
