WHEREAS, The daughter of Jaroslav and Marie Riha, the former 4 5 Eva Karolina Marie Riha was born in Jihlava, Czechoslovakia, on February 2, 1938; her family resisted the invading Nazi regime and 6 7 then escaped communism in 1950 by hiding in a produce van; as a refugee in Australia, she worked at Commonwealth Serum Laboratories 8 and was chosen to help develop the country's first batch of the Salk 9 polio vaccine; the Rihas were finally able to move to the U.S. in 10 11 1958, and she became a lab technician at the Southwest Foundation 12 for Research and Education in San Antonio; after citizenship in 1963, she married Dr. H. Herbert Hahn II; his career 13 14 in the U.S. Foreign Service took them to Cambodia and Ghana, and

they traveled the world extensively; and 15 WHEREAS, The Hahns ultimately settled in Temple to raise 16 their four children, Carla, Christopher, Catherine, and Steven; an 17 avid reader with many interests, Mrs. Hahn provided a lively 18 intellectual environment at home; she was a marvelous cook and 19 hostess, and her guests were always spellbound by her vivid 20 21 storytelling; in addition, she volunteered in the Independent School District for over a decade and served on the 22 23 city's Desegregation Committee, and she was an officer in the

- 3 the growth of communism; when her children were older, she realized

- 5 business; she also enjoyed working on the family ranch in western
- 6 Bell County; she and her husband shared a fulfilling 59-year
- 7 marriage until his passing; devoted to her loved ones, she
- 8 continued to prepare take-home gourmet meals for her children and
- 9 grandchildren's families until her final months; and
