21 has served as a member of the advisory board of the International

22 Center of The University of Texas at Dallas and as a member of the

23 board of governors of the Dallas Symphony Orchestra; he was named

- 6 1998; prior to his appointment as consul general, he was executive
- 7 director of the Institute for Mexicans Abroad, and he has served in
- 8 embassies in Brazil and Argentina; in 2022, he was promoted to the
- 9 rank of minister; he holds a law degree from the National Autonomous
- 10 University of Mexico and a master's degree in diplomatic studies
- 11 from the Matías Romero Institute; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Through his skill, expertise, and dedication,
- 13 Francisco de la Torre Galindo has earned the admiration and
- 14 appreciation of innumerable people in North Texas and beyond, and
- 15 it is indeed fitting to recognize his contributions as he embarks on
