A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to excess contributions and fees allocated to statutory 3 probate courts. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.00212, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 6 7 follows: (a) At the end of each state fiscal year, the comptroller 8 9 shall determine: (1) the amounts deposited in the judicial fund under 10 Section 133.151(c)(1), Local Government Code, from [by] statutory 11 12 probate courts fees remitted under Section 133.151(a)(1), Local Government Code, either: 13 14 (A) directly to the treasury by the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System for fees paid 15 using the electronic filing system established under Section 16 17 72.031; or 18 (B) to the comptroller in the manner provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 133, Local Government Code, for fees paid to 19 an officer of a court; and 20 21 (2) the sum of the amount paid under Section 22 25.0022(e) and the total amounts paid to the counties under Section 23 25.00211. (a-1) If the comptroller determines the total amount 24

1 deposited in the judicial fund by statutory probate courts in all counties as calculated under Subsection (a)(1) exceeds the sum 2 calculated under Subsection (a)(2) [that sum], the comptroller 3 [state] shall remit the excess proportionately to each county that 4 contributed [deposited] a greater amount to [in] the judicial fund 5 from fees collected by a statutory probate court than the amount the 6 county was paid under Section 25.00211, as adjusted in an equitable 7 manner to reflect the differences in the total amounts paid to the 8 counties under Section 25.00211. 9

10 SECTION 2. Section 25.0022(f), Government Code, is amended 11 to read as follows:

12 (f) Each county pays annually to the presiding judge, from fees allocated to the judicial education and support fund under 13 [collected pursuant to] Section 135.102 [118.052(2)(A)(vi)], Local 14 15 Government Code, the amount of the salary apportioned [to it] as provided by this section and the other expenses authorized by this 16 17 section. The presiding judge shall place each county's payment of salary and other expenses in an administrative fund, from which the 18 19 salary and other expenses are paid. The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments. 20

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 22 25.00212, Government Code, apply to amounts deposited in the 3 judicial fund under Section 133.151(c)(1), Local Government Code, 4 from fees collected by a statutory probate court before, on, or 25 after the effective date of this Act.

26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 27 last day of the legislative session.
