- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 403,

- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 403, Government Code, is 10 amended by adding Section 403.108 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 403.108. DEDICATION OF CERTAIN STATE MONEY FOR AD
- 12 VALOREM TAX RELIEF. (a) Not later than the 90th day of each state
- 13 fiscal year, the comptroller shall:
- 14 (1) determine the amount of money received from the
- 15 federal government by this state during the preceding state fiscal
- 16 year as reimbursement for border security costs incurred by this
- 17 state; and

- 18 (2) deposit an amount of general revenue equal to the
- 19 <u>amount determined under Subdivision (1) to the credit of an account</u>
- 20 <u>in the general revenue fund.</u>
- 21 (b) Money in the account described by Subsection (a)(2) may
- 22 be appropriated by the legislature only to provide ad valorem tax
- 23 relief.
