A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to limit the time in which the
- 2 legislature may enact or modify districts for the Texas Legislature
- 3 or the United States House of Representatives.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 28A to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28A. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c) of this
- 8 section, the legislature may not enact a bill that provides for an
- 9 apportionment or modification of senatorial or representative
- 10 districts at a time other than the time in which the legislature is
- 11 required to make an apportionment under Section 28 of this article.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) of this section,
- 13 the legislature may not enact a bill that provides for or modifies
- 14 the composition of districts for the election of members of the
- 15 United States House of Representatives at a time other than:
- 16 (1) the calendar year in which the federal decennial
- 17 census is released, if the census is released on or before September
- 18 <u>1; or</u>
- 19 (2) a 120-day period beginning on the day the census is
- 20 released, if the census is released after September 1.
- 21 (c) If a trial or appellate court or other governmental
- 22 agency with jurisdiction over the matter finds that one or more
- 23 <u>districts in effect for or previously enacted or ordered for the</u>
- 24 election of members of the legislature or the United States House of

- 1 Representatives are invalid or takes any action that has the effect
- 2 of prohibiting this state from holding elections in one or more of
- 3 those districts, the legislature may enact a bill described by
- 4 Subsection (a) or (b) of this section, as appropriate, relating to
- 5 the same legislative body within one year after the date of the
- 6 court or agency action, except that the legislature may not enact a
- 7 bill apportioning or modifying districts of a house of the
- 8 legislature during the period the Legislative Redistricting Board
- 9 has exclusive jurisdiction to act on those districts under Section
- 10 28 of this article.
- 11 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2026.
- 13 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 14 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to limit the time in
- 15 which the legislature may enact or modify districts for the Texas
- 16 Legislature or the United States House of Representatives."
