- 12 Evelyn "Milly" Williamson on July 12, 1958, and the couple shared a
- 13 fulfilling marriage that spanned 56 years until her passing; they

- 16 Cameron and Daniel, and one great-grandchild, Alister; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Over the course of a long and rewarding career in

- 19 and the Shelby Veterinary Center, and he was active in many
- 20 professional organizations; in 2008, he received the Distinguished
