2 passing of Dr. Jim B. Elam of Longview on July 13, 2025, at the age

3 of 89; and

WHEREAS, The son of Bryan and Allene Elam, Jim Elam was born

5 in Murfreesboro, Arkansas, on November 4, 1935, and he grew up with

6 the companionship of his sister, Betty Sue; he felt the call to the

7 ministry at the age of 15 and began preaching at a small church near

8 his hometown; in 1957, he enlisted in the U.S. Army, and he was

9 stationed in Germany and also served as director of the Army's

10 American Youth Association; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Elam earned a bachelor's degree from Texas

12 Christian University in 1961, and he later received a master of

13 divinity degree and a doctorate of ministry from Brite Divinity

14 School; ordained in 1964 at First Christian Church of Odessa, he

15 served numerous congregations over the course of a distinguished

16 ministerial career, including First Christian Church in Sulphur

17 Springs and First Christian Church in Duncanville; he went on to

18 lead First Christian Church in Longview as senior minister for 25

19 years, and following his retirement in 2001, he acted as interim

20 senior minister for several churches; and

21 WHEREAS, Passionate about community service, Dr. Elam helped

22 establish the Palmer Drug Abuse Program, and he was instrumental in

23 the formation of a group affectionately known as the "Good Guys" who

24 played a pivotal role in launching a number of initiatives, such as

- 3 moreover, he gave generously of his time and talents to various
- 4 other boards and organizations, including the Salvation Army, the
- 5 Kidney Foundation of Longview, and the Gregg County Juvenile Task
- 6 Force; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Elam shared a rewarding marriage of 61 years
- 8 with his wife, Mary Alice; he took great pride in his four children,
- 9 Matthew, Beth, Molly, and Margaret, and with the passing years, he
- 10 had the pleasure of seeing his treasured family grow to include
- 11 eight grandchildren, Adelynn, Sam, Elanor, Jack, Thomas, Oliver,
- 12 Benjamin, and Nathan; in his free time, he enjoyed following TCU
- 13 sports; and
- WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to his faith, his family, and his
- 15 community, Jim Elam earned the lasting respect and admiration of
- 16 all who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
