12 Luther Rice Seminary; his first full-time pastorate was to Woodrow

13 Baptist Church in Silsbee, and he went on to serve churches in

14 Winnie, Corsicana, Wichita Falls, Port Acres, and Lindale; and

WHEREAS, After leaving the pastorate in 1979 to devote

16 himself to evangelism and mission work, Dr. Roberts founded

17 Christian Foundations of Faith, Inc.; Belize became his primary

18 mission field, where he built churches, sponsored ministries, and

19 supported local preachers through resources and mentorship; over

20 the years, he became well-known for his "Sixty Second Sermon"

21 devotionals, newsletters, and television broadcasts that reached

22 countless people in North and Central America; and

23 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Pastor Roberts enjoyed the
