- Amend C.S.H.B. No. 15 (house committee report) as follows:
- 2 (1) On page 2, line 8, strike "only".
- 3 (2) On page 2, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:
- 4 (f-1) On completion of an investigation relating to alleged
- 5 license holder misconduct, a law enforcement agency shall permit
- 6 the following individuals to view any letter, memorandum, or
- 7 document placed in the license holder's department file relating
- 8 to the alleged misconduct:
- 9 (1) the individual who submitted the complaint of
- 10 alleged misconduct that was the subject of the investigation;
- 11 (2) any individual to whom the alleged misconduct that
- 12 was the subject of the investigation was directed; or
- 13 (3) the immediate family of an individual described by
- 14 Subdivision (2) if the individual is now deceased.
- 15 (f-2) A person permitted to view a letter, memorandum, or
- 16 document under Subsection (f-1) may not duplicate, record,
- 17 capture, or otherwise memorialize the letter, memorandum, or
- 18 document. A permitted viewing of a letter, memorandum, or document
- 19 under Subsection (f-1) is not considered to be a release of public
- 20 information for purposes of Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 21 (3) On page 2, line 11, strike "and (f)" and substitute "(f),
- 22 (f-1), and (f-2)".
