5	SECTION 1. Section 1431.001(2), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(2) "Eligible countywide district" means a flood
8	control district [or a hospital district] the boundaries of which
9	are substantially coterminous with the boundaries of a county with
10	a population of three million or more [or a hospital district
11	created in a county with a population of more than 1.2 million that
12	was not included in the boundaries of a hospital district before
13	September 1, 2003].

- 9 Sec. 271.0461. ADDITIONAL PURPOSE FOR CERTIFICATES:
- 10 DEMOLITION OF DANGEROUS STRUCTURES [OR RESTORATION OF HISTORIC
- 11 STRUCTURES]. Certificates may be issued by any municipality for
- 12 the payment of contractual obligations to be incurred in
- 13 demolishing dangerous structures [or restoring historic
- 14 structures] and may be sold for cash, subject to the restrictions
- 15 and other conditions of Section 271.050.
- SECTION 4. Section 271.047(c), Local Government Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) A certificate may not mature over a period greater than
- 19 30 [40] years from the date of the certificate and may not bear
- 20 interest at a rate greater than that allowed by Chapter 1204,
- 21 Government Code.
- SECTION 5. Section 271.049(c), Local Government Code, is
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 (c) If before the date tentatively set for the authorization
- 25 of the issuance of the certificates or if before the authorization,
- 26 the municipal secretary or clerk if the issuer is a municipality,
- 27 or the county clerk if the issuer is a county, receives a petition

- 1 signed by at least <u>two</u> [five] percent of the registered [qualified]
- 2 voters of the issuer protesting the issuance of the certificates,
- 3 the issuer may not authorize the issuance of the certificates
- 4 unless the issuance is approved at an election ordered, held, and
- 5 conducted in the manner provided for bond elections under Chapter
- 6 1251, Government Code.
- 7 SECTION 6. Section 271.0525(c), Local Government Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (c) A petition to protest the issuance of refinancing
- 10 certificates under this section must be signed by at least two
- 11 percent of the registered [a number of qualified] voters of the
- 12 county [, residing in the county, equal to at least five percent of
- 13 the number of votes cast in that county for governor in the most
- 14 recent general election at which that office was filled].
- 15 SECTION 7. Section 271.046, Local Government Code, is
- 16 repealed.
- 17 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 an anticipation note or certificate of obligation issued on or
- 19 after the effective date of this Act. An anticipation note or
- 20 certificate of obligation issued before the effective date of this
- 21 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the note or
- 22 certificate was issued, and the former law is continued in effect
- 23 for that purpose.
- SECTION 9. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 25 last day of the legislative session.
