## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring voter approval for certain local tax rate
- 3 increases adopted pursuant to a disaster declaration.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Voter approval of disaster-related tax rate 6 increases.
- 7 (1) This section applies to any taxing unit, other
- 8 than a school district, that adopted a tax rate under Section
- 9 26.042(c-1), Tax Code, allowing use of the 8% voter-approved rate
- 10 calculation due to a disaster declaration, during the period from
- 11 May 28, 2025, through December 31, 2025.
- 12 (2) A taxing unit described by Subsection (1) may not
- 13 continue to impose a tax rate authorized under Section 26.042(c-1),
- 14 Tax Code, for more than 30 days unless the increased tax rate is
- 15 approved by voters at an election held within 30 days.
- 16 (3) If no such election is held or the tax rate is not
- 17 approved by voters within the 30-day period, the taxing unit's tax
- 18 rate shall automatically revert to the tax rate in effect
- 19 immediately preceding the disaster-related increase.
- 20 (4) An election under this section must be held in
- 21 compliance with tax rate approval elections under Chapter 26, Tax
- 22 Code.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 4 legislative session.
