AN ACT

2	relating to the administration of an election for a member of a

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.0581(a), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) An election for trustees of an independent school
8	district shall be held on the same date as the general election for
9	<pre>state and county officers[+</pre>
10	[(1) the election for the members of the governing
11	body of a municipality located in the school district;
12	[(2) the general election for state and county
13	officers;
14	[(3) the election for the members of the governing
15	body of a hospital district, if the school district:
16	[(A) is wholly or partly located in a county with
17	a population of less than 50,000 that is adjacent to a county with a
18	population of more than three million; and
19	[(B) held its election for trustees jointly with
20	the election for the members of the governing body of the hospital
21	district before May 2007; or
22	[(4) the election for the members of the governing
23	board of a public junior college district in which the school
24	district is wholly or partly located].

- 1 SECTION 2. Sections 11.059(a), (b), (c), and (d), Education
- 2 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a) A trustee of an independent school district serves a
- 4 term of [three or] four years.
- 5 (b) [Elections for trustees with three-year terms shall be
- 6 held annually. The terms of one-third of the trustees, or as near
- 7 to one-third as possible, expire each year.
- 8 [(c)] Elections for trustees [with four-year terms] shall
- 9 be held biennially. The terms of one-half of the trustees, or as
- 10 near to one-half as possible, expire every two years.
- (c) $[\frac{d}{d}]$ A board policy must state the schedule on which
- 12 specific terms expire.
- SECTION 3. Section 11.065(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (a) Sections 11.052(g) and (h) [and Sections 11.059(a) and
- 16 (b) do not apply to the board of trustees of a school district if:
- 17 (1) the district's central administrative office is
- 18 located in a county with a population of more than 2.5 million; and
- 19 (2) the district's student enrollment is more than
- 20 125,000 and less than 200,000.
- SECTION 4. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (a-4) to read as follows:
- 23 <u>(a-4)</u> The governing body of an independent school district
- 24 that holds its general election for officers on a date other than
- 25 the date of the general election for state and county officers
- 26 shall, not later than December 31, 2026, change the date on which
- 27 the governing body holds its general election for officers to that
