## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to a grant program to assist nonprofit organizations,

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 771, Health and Safety
- 8 Code, is amended by adding Section 771.080 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 771.080. EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES GRANT
- 10 PROGRAM. (a) From money appropriated or otherwise available for
- 11 that purpose, the commission shall establish and administer a grant
- 12 program to assist nonprofit organizations, regional planning
- 13 commissions, and emergency communication districts with providing
- 14 emergency communications services, including 9-1-1 service, to end
- 15 <u>users in this state.</u>
- 16 (b) The commission by rule shall:
- 17 (1) develop an application process for an entity
- 18 applying for a grant under this section;
- 19 (2) develop eligibility and selection criteria for an
- 20 entity applying for a grant under this section;
- 21 (3) develop procedures for commission approval of the
- 22 use of grant money awarded under this section; and
- 23 (4) establish accountability controls for grant
- 24 recipients to ensure the public purpose of providing emergency

- 1 communications services is accomplished and this state receives a
- 2 return benefit.
- 3 (c) In addition to money appropriated by the legislature,
- 4 the commission may accept gifts, grants, or donations from any
- 5 source to administer and finance the grant program established
- 6 under this section.
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the Commission on State Emergency Communications shall
- 9 establish the emergency communications services grant program
- 10 required by Section 771.080, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 13 last day of the legislative session.
