A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to election procedures regarding accepting a voter with a
- 3 residence address that is not current and the immediate effect of a
- 4 voter's registration after the registrar's receipt of certain
- 5 change of address notices.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 15.025(a), Election Code, as effective
- 8 September 1, 2025, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and $[\tau]$ (d) $[\tau]$ and
- 10 (e)], the registration of a voter described by this subsection
- 11 whose information is changed on the registration records becomes
- 12 effective as to the change on the 30th day after:
- 13 (1) the date the voter submits to the registrar a
- 14 notice of a change in registration information under Section 15.021
- or a response under Section 15.053, indicating the change; or
- 16 (2) the date the voter submits a statement of
- 17 residence to an election officer under Section 63.0011 or a
- 18 registration application or change of address to an agency employee
- 19 under Chapter 20, indicating the change.
- SECTION 2. Sections 63.0011(b) and (c), Election Code, as
- 21 effective September 1, 2025, are amended to read as follows:
- (b) If the voter's residence address is not current because
- 23 the voter has changed residence within the county, the voter may
- 24 vote, if otherwise eligible, in the election precinct in which the

- 1 voter <u>is registered</u> [resides] if the voter resides in the county in
- 2 which the voter is registered and, if applicable:
- 3 (1) resides in the political subdivision served by the
- 4 authority ordering the election if the political subdivision is
- 5 other than the county; or
- 6 (2) resides in the territory covered by the election
- 7 <u>in a less-than-countywide election ordered by the governor or a</u>
- 8 county authority.
- 9 (c) Before being accepted for voting, the voter must execute
- 10 and submit to an election officer a statement including:
- 11 (1) a statement that the voter satisfies the
- 12 applicable residence requirements [requirement] prescribed by
- 13 Subsection (b);
- 14 (2) all of the information that a person must include
- in an application to register to vote under Section 13.002; and
- 16 (3) the date the statement is submitted to the
- 17 election officer[; and
- 18 [(4) a request to the registrar to change the voter's
- 19 registration address to the address at which the voter resides].
- SECTION 3. Section 15.025(e), Election Code, as effective
- 21 September 1, 2025, is repealed.
- 22 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 a notice of a voter's change of address submitted on or after the
- 24 effective date of this Act.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 3 legislative session.
