8	PROPERTY. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Day-care center" has the meaning assigned by
10	Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
11	(2) "Public property" includes a street, highway,
12	alley, public park, or sidewalk.
13	(3) "School" means a private or public elementary or
14	secondary school.
15	(4) "School or day-care center property" means all
16	land and buildings owned or leased by a school or day-care center on
17	which an activity sponsored by the school or day-care center is
18	being conducted.
19	(b) A person commits an offense if the person:
20	(1) enters or remains on:
21	(A) school or day-care center property; or
22	(B) public property located within 250 feet of
23	school or day-care center property;
24	(2) engages in conduct that is disruptive,

- 1 threatening, or harassing to a student enrolled at or employee of
- 2 the school or day-care center or to the operations of the school or
- 3 day-care center;
- 4 (3) does not have:
- 5 (A) a reason or relationship for entering or
- 6 remaining on the property that involves custody of or
- 7 responsibility for a student enrolled at the school or day-care
- 8 center; or
- 9 (B) written permission from an authorized
- 10 representative of the school or day-care center;
- 11 (4) receives a reasonable request to depart by an
- 12 administrator, educator, or security personnel officer employed by
- 13 the school or day-care center; and
- 14 (5) fails to depart.
- 15 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 16 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 17 also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
- 18 actor may be prosecuted under either section or both sections.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect December 1, 2025.
