H.J.R. No. 12

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the repeal of
2 the Dementia Prevention and Research Institute of Texas and the
3 Dementia Prevention and Research Fund to provide money for research
4 on and prevention and treatment of dementia, Alzheimer's disease,
5 Parkinson's disease, and related disorders in this state, and
6 transferring from that fund \$3 billion to Texas Education Agency
7 for property tax relief.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

9 SECTION 1. Article III, Section 68, Texas Constitution, is
10 repealed.

11 SECTION 2. The comptroller shall transfer any money
12 appropriated or transferred to the Dementia Prevention and Research
13 Fund to the Texas Education Agency to reduce the state compression
14 percentage under Section 48.255, Education Code, to the lowest
15 possible percentage.

16 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
20 repeal of the Dementia Prevention and Research Institute of Texas
21 and the Dementia Prevention and Research Fund to provide money for
22 research on and prevention and treatment of dementia, Alzheimer's
23 disease, Parkinson's disease, and related disorders in this state,
24 and transferring from that fund \$3 billion to Texas Education

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1 Agency for property tax relief."
