A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature
- 2 to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of the amount
- 3 of the market value of residential real property that arises from
- 4 the installation in the property of certain energy
- 5 efficiency-related improvements.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-m-2 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1-m-2. The legislature by general law may exempt from
- 10 <u>ad valorem taxation the portion of the market value of residential</u>
- 11 real property that arises from the installation in the property of
- 12 an energy efficiency-related improvement. The legislature may
- 13 <u>define "energy efficiency-related improvement" for purposes of</u>
- 14 this section and may prescribe additional eligibility requirements
- 15 for the exemption provided by this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held May 2, 2026. The
- 18 ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 20 legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of
- 21 the amount of the market value of residential real property that
- 22 arises from the installation in the property of certain energy
- 23 efficiency-related improvements."
