R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Aristoi Classical Academy has been named Best
2 Charter School in the *Houston Chronicle's* 2025 Best of the Best
3 list; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in 1996 as West Houston Charter School,
5 Aristoi Classical Academy is a tuition-free, public charter school
6 that offers a liberal arts education to students in kindergarten
7 through 12th grade; over the years, the academy has grown to
8 encompass two campuses in Katy and one in Cypress, and enrollment
9 has increased to more than 1,500 learners; and

10 WHEREAS, Through its classical curriculum, Aristoi strives
11 to foster in its students a love of learning and a drive to become
12 responsible members of society; following the natural stages of a
13 child's intellectual development, the school organizes instruction
14 into the three stages, grammar, logic, and rhetoric, with the goal
15 of teaching students to listen carefully, reason critically,
16 communicate clearly, and write persuasively; and

18 achieved mastery on State of Texas Assessments of Academic
19 Readiness, and they have also earned high marks on the Preliminary
20 SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test; the academy is ably

23 positive values and personal growth, Aristoi Classical Academy is
