2 the passing of Blair Elizabeth Harber of Dallas, who was tragically
3 lost during the July 2025 flooding in Kerr County along with her
4 sister, Brooke Harber, and her grandparents, Charlene and Mike
5 Harber; and

6 WHEREAS, The daughter of RJ and Annie Harber, Blair Harber
7 was born on December 29, 2011, and she was 13 years old at the time
8 of her passing; she shared a strong bond with her younger sister,
9 Brooke; and

10 WHEREAS, A student at St. Rita Catholic School, Blair was
11 enrolled in advanced classes and involved in several activities,
12 including the yearbook and speech and drama programs; she was also a
13 cheerleader and a member of the volleyball, basketball, and
14 lacrosse teams, and as a student ambassador, she guided the
15 families of prospective students through the school; and

16 WHEREAS, Blair drew strength from her faith, and she took a
17 deep interest in her religious studies at St. Rita; she is
18 remembered for her kind heart and her passion for serving others;

20 WHEREAS, Although it is immeasurably painful to say goodbye
21 to someone so young and full of promise, those mourning the loss of
22 Blair Harber may find comfort in knowing that their lives have been
23 forever enriched by the joyful times they spent in her company; now,
