R E S O L U T I O N

3 Dallas, who was tragically lost in the July 4, 2025, flooding in
4 Kerr County; and

6 Peck was born on September 18, 2016, and she was eight years old at
7 the time of her passing; the daughter of Missy and Tim Peck, she was
8 blessed with the companionship of her younger brother, Holden, and
9 she benefited from the love and support of an extended family that
10 included her grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, and godparents,
11 along with her Boston terrier, Ollie, who was seldom far from her
12 side; and

14 and her favorite part of the day was recess, when she often guided
15 her classmates in their work at "Lulu's Spa"; outside of school

19 and she spent many happy hours talking and staging dance parties
