1 WHEREAS, Antioch Georgetown is hosting a ground-breaking
2 ceremony for its new church building on August 24, 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, Organized in 2017, Antioch Georgetown held its first
4 services at Carver Elementary School; three years later, the
5 congregation moved to Brookwood in Georgetown's Amazing Grace
6 Building, where attendance rapidly grew, staffing increased, and
7 the church began offering additional programs and services; and

8 WHEREAS, Today, Antioch Georgetown furthers its impact
9 through partnerships with such organizations as Mission 4031,
10 Helping Hands of Georgetown, Soul Survivor Outdoor, and Africa New
11 Life; in addition, the members of the congregation have established
12 a variety of small groups that foster fellowship and spiritual
13 enrichment among attendees; the church is served by lead pastor
14 Andy Comer, as well as a host of other leaders and clergy, including
15 Stephen Castleberry, experience pastor, and Darrell Hudson, care
16 pastor; and

17 WHEREAS, Since its founding, Antioch Georgetown has been a
18 source of inspiration and guidance to its members, and the
19 construction of a sanctuary will allow the church to serve the needs
20 of even more congregants in the years to come; now, therefore, be it
