1 WHEREAS, Pearson Elementary School in Mission is marking its  
2 70th anniversary with a celebration on September 6, 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, One of the first five campuses established in the  
4 Mission Consolidated Independent School District, Pearson  
5 Elementary opened with 11 classrooms on September 6, 1955; the  
6 school is named for the late Lucille Pearson, a Mission High School  
7 graduate and education advocate whose tireless work left an  
8 indelible mark on the community; and

9 WHEREAS, Today, principal Melissa E. Davis is at the helm of  
10 Pearson, which serves approximately 300 students in early education  
11 and kindergarten through fifth grade; under her able leadership,  
12 the school's faculty members have earned a reputation for fostering  
13 academic excellence while helping to close educational gaps and  
14 guiding the cognitive, social, emotional, and mental development of  
15 students; moreover, following its receipt of a Project Fit America  
16 grant from the Valley Baptist Legacy Foundation, the campus  
17 launched a fitness program designed to inspire youth to lead active  
18 and healthy lifestyles; and

20 commitment to growth, innovation, and success, Pearson Elementary  
21 has long provided young Texans with a strong foundation on which to
