Martin Garza was born in San Antonio on October 21, 1940; he grew up

6 on the Westside with four siblings, Efrain, Mary Alice, Emma, and

7 Christine; he began working at the family business, Garza's Service

8 Station & Garage, at an early age; as quarterback for the Fox Tech

9 High School football team, he was named to the All-District and

10 All-City teams before graduating in 1959; that same year, he was

11 recognized by the San Antonio Express-News for saving a young girl

12 from drowning; an alumnus of St. Mary's University, he went on to

13 earn a master's degree in social work from Our Lady of the Lake

14 University; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Garza dedicated his career to helping others; he

16 served as program director of the San Antonio Neighborhood Youth

17 Organization before being hired by the U.S. Department of Labor;

18 subsequently, he was employed at the House of Neighborly Service,

19 and in 1971, he began his tenure with MHMR's drug dependence

20 program; he advanced rapidly to executive roles, including chief of

21 narcotic addiction and rehabilitation, director of intake and

22 outpatient services, and, ultimately, director of the drug

23 dependence program; the San Antonio Express-News wrote about his
