6 Lytal was born in Houston on May 25, 2017, and she was eight years
7 old at the time of her passing; she shared a strong bond with her
8 younger sister, Emmalynn, and she benefited from the love and
9 support of an extended family that included her grandparents,

12 School, where she excelled academically and was recognized with the

16 becoming an Alamo Heights High School cheerleader, and she hoped to
17 one day attend The University of Texas at Austin and join Kappa

19 WHEREAS, Outside of school, Kellyanne was involved in Girl
20 Scouts, and she enjoyed such activities as roller blading, playing
21 softball and soccer, and participating in gymnastics; she also had
22 a passion for singing and dancing, sewing, and fashion, and she
23 spent many happy hours shopping with her mother, playing sports
24 with her father, and being silly with her sister; moreover,

1 Kellyanne's faith played an important role in her life, and she took
2 pleasure in reading Bible stories and attending Sunday school; and

3 WHEREAS, Although her time on this earth was far too brief,
4 Kellyanne Lytal was a ray of light in the lives of those who held her
5 dear, and they will never forget the joy, laughter, and love that
6 she shared with them; now, therefore, be it
