Section 2206.003, Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to the taking of private property by eminent 18 19 domain for which a condemnation petition is filed on or after the 20 effective date of this Act. A taking for which a condemnation 21 petition is filed before the effective date of this Act is governed 22 by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 23
