## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to election procedures regarding accepting a voter with a
- 3 residence address that is not current and the immediate effect of a
- 4 voter's registration after the registrar's receipt of certain
- 5 change of address notices.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 15.025(a), Election Code, as effective
- 8 September 1, 2025, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and  $[\tau]$  (d)  $[\tau]$  and
- 10 <del>(e)</del>], the registration of a voter described by this subsection
- 11 whose information is changed on the registration records becomes
- 12 effective as to the change on the 30th day after:
- 13 (1) the date the voter submits to the registrar a
- 14 notice of a change in registration information under Section 15.021
- 15 or a response under Section 15.053, indicating the change; or
- 16 (2) the date the voter submits a statement of
- 17 residence to an election officer under Section 63.0011 or a
- 18 registration application or change of address to an agency employee
- 19 under Chapter 20, indicating the change.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 63.0011, Election Code, as effective
- 21 September 1, 2025, is amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c)
- 22 and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 23 (b) If the voter's residence address is not current because
- 24 the voter has changed residence within the county, the voter may

- 1 vote, if otherwise eligible, in the election precinct in which the
- 2 voter is registered [resides] if the voter resides in the county in
- 3 which the voter is registered.
- 4 (b-1) A voter accepted for voting under Subsection (b) may
- 5 only cast a provisional ballot under Section 63.011 and may only
- 6 vote on each office or proposition stating a measure to be voted on
- 7 <u>countywide.</u>
- 8 (c) Before being accepted for voting, the voter must execute
- 9 and submit to an election officer a statement including:
- 10 (1) a statement that the voter satisfies the
- 11 applicable residence <u>requirements</u> [requirement] prescribed by
- 12 Subsection (b);
- 13 (2) all of the information that a person must include
- 14 in an application to register to vote under Section 13.002; and
- 15 (3) the date the statement is submitted to the
- 16 election officer[+ and
- 17 [(4) a request to the registrar to change the voter's
- 18 registration address to the address at which the voter resides].
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 63.011(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) A person to whom Section 63.001(g), 63.0011(b-1), or
- 22 63.009 applies may cast a provisional ballot if the person executes
- 23 an affidavit stating that the person:
- 24 (1) is a registered voter in the precinct in which the
- 25 person seeks to vote; and
- 26 (2) is eligible to vote in the election.
- 27 SECTION 4. Section 15.025(e), Election Code, as effective

- 1 September 1, 2025, is repealed.
- 2 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a notice of a voter's change of address submitted on or after the
- 4 effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. Section 63.0011, Election Code, as amended by
- 6 this Act, applies only to an election ordered on or after the
- 7 effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 13 legislative session.
