Relating to resident youth camp emergency plans and preparedness;
authorizing a civil penalty.
- HB 2 King
Relating to disaster preparedness, response, and recovery, including
required training for justices of the peace and responding to mass fatality
events; requiring a license; authorizing fees.
- HB 3 King
Relating to the interoperability of emergency communication equipment and
infrastructure in this state, including the creation and operation of the
Texas Interoperability Council, a grant program administered by the council,
and the purchase of certain public safety radio communication systems.
- HB 5 Bonnen / et al.
Relating to making supplemental appropriations for disaster relief and
giving direction and adjustment authority regarding those appropriations.
- HB 20 Darby / Louderback / Barry / et al.
Relating to certain measures to prevent and reduce fraudulent charitable
solicitations and theft during disasters, including establishing a voluntary
accreditation program for disaster relief organizations; creating a criminal
offense; increasing a criminal penalty; providing a civil cause of action.

Relating to the authority of the comptroller to provide funding for the
deployment and operation of certain emergency communication equipment.
