FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.

- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. 6 (house committee report) by adding the 2 following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 4 SECTION . Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended by adding Section 67.0115 to read as follows: 5 6 Sec. 67.0115. ELECTRIC GENERATION. (a) A corporation may 7 generate electric power for use in the corporation's operations, 8 limited to: 9 (1) powering water well pumps, service pumps, and other 10 equipment for the production, treatment, and transportation of raw 11 water; and
- 12 (2) powering infrastructure for the treatment and
 13 delivery of potable drinking water.
- (b) For the purposes of Subsection (a), a corporation
 operating solely as a wholesale water supplier or sewer service in
- a county with a population of less than 350,000 may generate excess
- 17 electric power in conjunction with the uses described in Subsection
- 18 (a) for sale in the ERCOT power region to provide revenue for the
- 19 corporation only if the corporation:
- 20 (1) primarily generates electric power solely for the
- 21 <u>uses described in Subsection (a); and</u>
- (2) registers as a power generation company under
- 23 <u>Section 39.351</u>, Utilities Code.
- (c) A corporation that generates electric power for sale
- 25 under Subsection (b) shall account for and use the revenue from
- 26 those sales in a manner that complies with Section 67.004. The

- 1 revenue that accrues from those sales of electric power may be
- 2 <u>used</u> by the corporation only for:
- 3 (1) the corporation's costs of producing and selling
- 4 electric power, including administration, employees, equipment,
- 5 <u>fuel</u>, and maintenance; or
- 6 (2) a purpose described by Section 67.002.
