- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. 30 (house committee printing) as follows:
- 2 (1) On page 4, line 2, strike "and 41.017" and substitute
- 3 "41.017, and 41.018".
- 4 (2) On page 8, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:
- 5 Sec. 41.018. PRESERVATION OF PRIVILEGES AND PROTECTED
- 6 INFORMATION. (a) Nothing in Section 41.015 or 41.016 may be
- 7 construed to:
- 8 (1) abrogate or otherwise impair any privilege
- 9 recognized under the Texas Rules of Evidence or other applicable
- 10 law, including the attorney-client privilege, the work-product
- 11 doctrine, or any other legal privilege protecting communications
- 12 or materials prepared in anticipation of litigation;
- 13 (2) authorize or require the disclosure of any
- 14 communication protected by the physician-patient privilege under
- 15 Section 773.091, Health and Safety Code, or other applicable law;
- 16 <u>or</u>
- 17 (3) authorize or require the disclosure of any
- 18 individually identifiable health information in a manner that
- 19 would violate the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability
- 20 Act of 1996 (Pub. L. No. 104-191), including the regulations
- 21 adopted under that Act in 45 C.F.R. Parts 160 and 164.
- 22 (b) Any disclosure or discovery authorized by this chapter
- 23 must comply with all applicable federal and state laws governing
- 24 medical privacy and confidentiality, including the Health
- 25 Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (Pub. L.
- No. 104-191) and Chapter 181, Health and Safety Code.
