Amend **SB 2** (senate committee report) in SECTION 2 of the bill as follows:

(1) In added Section 29.358(b), Education Code, strike Subdivision (1) (page 4, lines 42 through 45) and substitute the following:

(1) for a private school, demonstrates:

(A) annual administration of a nationally norm-referenced assessment instrument or the appropriate assessment instrument required under Subchapter B, Chapter 39; and (B) the adoption and implementation of a policy

that prohibits the school from discriminating against a child or the child's family, including by denying the child admission to the school, on the basis of religion, race, ethnicity, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender, or gender identity;

(2) Between added Sections 29.358 and 29.3585, Education Code (page 5, between lines 56 and 57), insert the following appropriately numbered section:

Sec. 29.__. REQUIRED POSTING OF CIVIL RIGHTS VIOLATIONS BY PRIVATE SCHOOLS. (a) Each private school receiving money distributed under the program shall maintain an Internet website that includes information regarding complaints received by the school that allege the school violated the civil rights of a student enrolled at or an employee of the school. The information:

(1) must include the resolution of each complaint; and (2) may not contain personally identifiable information of a student or employee whose civil rights were alleged to be violated.

(b) The comptroller shall adopt rules as necessary to ensure compliance with the requirements regarding the confidentiality of student educational information under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g).
