Amend **CSSB 865** (senate committee report) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION \_\_\_\_. Section 38.018, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 38.018. [PROCEDURES RECARDING RESPONSE TO] CARDIAC <u>EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN</u> [ARREST]. (a) Each school district and private school shall develop <u>and implement a cardiac emergency</u> <u>response plan that establishes</u> safety procedures for a district or school employee or <u>other appropriate personnel</u> [student] to follow in responding to a medical emergency involving cardiac arrest <u>on</u> <u>district or school grounds</u>[, including the appropriate response time in administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation, using an automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, or calling a local emergency medical <u>services provider</u>].

(b) In developing the plan, the district or school shall:

(1) work directly with local emergency services providers to integrate the plan with the providers' protocols; and

(2) incorporate evidence-based practices of a nationally recognized, guidelines-based organization focused on emergency cardiovascular care.

(c) The plan must include at a minimum:

(1) the establishment of a cardiac emergency response team;

(2) procedures for activating the cardiac emergency response team in response to a medical emergency involving cardiac arrest;

(3) the dissemination of the plan throughout each district or school campus;

(4) ongoing training in first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillators, as defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, using evidence-based guidelines, for appropriate district or school employees, including school coaches, school nurses, and athletic trainers;

(5) annual practice drills in responding to a medical

emergency involving cardiac arrest; and

(6) annual review, evaluation, and, if necessary, modification of the plan.

(d) A private school is required to develop <u>a cardiac</u> <u>emergency response plan</u> [safety procedures] under this section only if the school receives an automated external defibrillator from the agency or receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an automated external defibrillator.

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Not later than the first instructional day of the 2027-2028 school year, each public school and private school to which Section 38.018, Education Code, as amended by this Act, applies shall implement a cardiac emergency response plan as required by that section.

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
