1	AN ACT
2	relating to the acquisition or use of certain foreign equipment or
3	services by a governmental entity.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter $423$ , Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 423. [USE OF] UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
8	SECTION 2. Sections 423.001, 423.002, 423.003, 423.004,
9	423.0045, 423.0046, 423.005, 423.006, 423.007, 423.008, and
10	423.009, Government Code, are designated as Subchapter A, Chapter
11	423, Government Code, and a heading is added to Subchapter A to read
12	as follows:
13	SUBCHAPTER A. REGULATION OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
14	SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 423, Government Code, as
15	added by this Act, is amended by adding Section 423.010 to read as
16	follows:
17	Sec. 423.010. ACQUISITION OR USE OF CERTAIN FOREIGN
18	UNMANNED AIRCRAFT OR RELATED EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES BY GOVERNMENTAL
19	ENTITY PROHIBITED. (a) In this section:
20	(1) "Company" means a sole proprietorship,
21	organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint
22	venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or
23	limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary,
24	majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those

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1	entities or business associations, that exists to make a profit.
2	(2) "Governmental entity" means this state, a
3	political subdivision of this state, or an agency of this state or a
4	political subdivision of this state.
5	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a governmental
6	entity may not acquire or use an unmanned aircraft, or related
7	equipment or services, produced or provided by a company that the
8	governmental entity knows or has reason to believe is:
9	(1) owned by or the majority of stock or other
10	ownership interest of the company is held or controlled by:
11	(A) the government of China, Iran, North Korea,
12	Russia, or Syria; or
13	(B) a company or other entity, including a
14	government entity, that is owned or controlled by the government of
15	<u>China, Iran, North Korea, Russia, or Syria; or</u>
16	(2) headquartered in China, Iran, North Korea, Russia,
17	<u>or Syria.</u>
18	(c) The prohibition described by Subsection (b) applies
19	regardless of whether:
20	(1) the company's or its parent company's securities
21	are publicly traded; or
22	(2) the company or its parent company is listed on a
23	public stock exchange as a Chinese, Iranian, North Korean, Russian,
24	<u>or Syrian company.</u>
25	(d) A governmental entity that, before September 1, 2025,
26	acquired, or entered into a contract or agreement to acquire, an
27	unmanned aircraft or related equipment or services described by

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1	Subsection (b) may continue to use the unmanned aircraft or related
2	equipment or services until September 1, 2030.
3	SECTION 4. Chapter 423, Government Code, is amended by
4	adding Subchapter B to read as follows:
5	SUBCHAPTER B. GRANT PROGRAM
6	Sec. 423.051. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "program"
7	means the Law Enforcement Secure Unmanned Aircraft Grant Program
8	administered under this subchapter.
9	Sec. 423.052. ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM. (a) From money
10	appropriated for the purpose, the attorney general shall establish
11	a grant program under this subchapter to provide grants to law
12	enforcement agencies to replace working equipment prohibited under
13	Section 423.010 that was actively in use by the law enforcement
14	agencies immediately before September 1, 2025, and that has not
15	reached its end of life before that date.
16	(b) The attorney general shall award grants under the
17	program from money appropriated for purposes of the program.
18	Sec. 423.053. GRANT APPLICATION. (a) A law enforcement
19	agency may apply for a grant from the attorney general in the form
20	and manner prescribed by the attorney general.
21	(b) The grant application must include the number and types
22	of unmanned aircraft or related equipment that require replacement.
23	Sec. 423.054. USE OF FUNDS. Grant recipients may use funds
24	only to purchase replacement unmanned aircraft or related equipment
25	that complies with Section 423.010.
26	Sec. 423.055. SURRENDER OF REPLACED UNMANNED AIRCRAFT OR
27	RELATED EQUIPMENT. To enable the designated entity to study or

1 dispose of the aircraft or related equipment, a grant recipient promptly shall surrender to an entity designated by the attorney 2 general the prohibited unmanned aircraft or related equipment with 3 respect to which the grant was awarded. 4 5 Sec. 423.056. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter expires on the second anniversary of the date that all money 6 7 appropriated for the grant program established under this 8 subchapter has been expended. 9 SECTION 5. Chapter 2054, Government Code, is amended by 10 adding Subchapter T to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER T. MODEL SECURITY PLAN REGARDING CERTAIN FOREIGN 11 12 TELECOMMUNICATIONS OR VIDEO SURVEILLANCE TECHNOLOGIES Sec. 2054.651. MODEL SECURITY PLAN FOR PROHIBITED OR 13 SUSPECT TECHNOLOGIES. (a) In this section, "company" and 14 15 "governmental entity" have the meanings assigned by Section 423.010. 16 17 (b) The department shall create and as necessary amend a model security plan for prohibited or suspect technologies to 18 address a governmental entity's acquisition or 19 use of telecommunications or video surveillance equipment or services 20 that may present a risk to state security. 21 (c) The model security plan must list known companies that 22 produce or provide telecommunications or video surveillance 23 24 equipment or services that may present a risk to state security. The list must include any foreign company that is: 25 26 (1) described by Section 423.010; 27 (2) prohibited from participating in federal

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1 contracts under Section 889, John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (Pub. L. No. 115-232), or 2 3 other federal law; or 4 (3) considered by the department to pose a risk to 5 state security. 6 (d) The department shall make the model security plan 7 created under this section available to governmental entities. SECTION 6. Section 423.010(b), Government Code, as added by 8 this Act: 9 10 (1)applies to the acquisition of an unmanned aircraft or related equipment or services on or after the effective date of 11 12 this Act, except that a contract or agreement to purchase or otherwise acquire an unmanned aircraft or related equipment or 13 14 services described by that subsection that is entered into before 15 the effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act; and

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16 (2) except as otherwise provided by Section 17 423.010(d), Government Code, as added by this Act, applies to the 18 use of an unmanned aircraft or related equipment or services on or 19 after the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the 20 unmanned aircraft or related equipment or services were acquired 21 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

22 SECTION 7. Not later than December 1, 2025, the Department 23 of Information Resources shall create the initial model security 24 plan required by Section 2054.651, Government Code, as added by 25 this Act.

26 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
