A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the school safety allotment under the Foundation School
3 Program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 48.115, Education Code, is amended by
6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c-2) to read as
7 follows:

8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), a school
9 district is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the sum of the
10 following amounts or a greater amount provided by appropriation:

11 (1) \$14 [~~\$10~~] for each student in average daily
12 attendance, plus \$1 for each student in average daily attendance
13 per every \$50 by which the district's maximum basic allotment under
14 Section 48.051 exceeds \$6,160, prorated as necessary; and

15 (2) \$37,000 [~~\$15,000~~] per campus.

16 (c-2) Not later than December 1 of each year, each school
17 district shall submit to the agency a report accounting for the
18 expenditure of funds received under this section.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
