- ARTICLE 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDING 5
- 6 SECTION 1.01. (a) The legislature, acting with the
- 7 governor, has the solemn duty to protect and defend the citizens of
- this state and maintain sovereignty over this state's borders. 8
- 9 (b) An individual entering this state from a foreign country
- shall enter through a legal port of entry. 10
- ARTICLE 2. BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS 11
- SECTION 2.01. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by 12
- adding Chapter 795 to read as follows: 13
- 14 CHAPTER 795. BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS WITH UNITED MEXICAN

- 16 Sec. 795.001. AUTHORITY FOR AGREEMENTS AND ENGAGEMENT WITH

- 2 An individual appointed under this subsection:
- 3 (1) may operate within the United Mexican States as
- 4 practicable; and
- 5 (2) is subject to Chapter 572 in the same manner as if
- 6 the individual were a state employee.
- 7 ARTICLE 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 8 SECTION 3.01. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 9 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 10 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 11 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 12 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
