BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS 11 SECTION 2.01. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by 12 adding Chapter 795 to read as follows: 13 14 CHAPTER 795. BORDER PROTECTION AGREEMENTS WITH UNITED MEXICAN 15 STATES 16 Sec. 795.001. AUTHORITY FOR AGREEMENTS AND ENGAGEMENT WITH AUTHORITIES OF UNITED MEXICAN STATES. (a) On behalf of this state, 17 the governor may coordinate, develop, and execute agreements with 18 the United Mexican States and the states of the United Mexican 19 States regarding the authority of this state to protect and defend 20 its citizens. 21 22 (b) The governor may appoint a group of individuals 23 responsible for meeting in person with the appropriate local, state, and federal authorities of the United Mexican States to 24

2	The group appointed under this subsection may operate within the
3	United Mexican States as practicable.
4	ARTICLE 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
5	SECTION 3.01. This Act takes effect immediately if it
6	receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
7	house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
8	If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
9	effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
