A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the inclusion of instruction regarding the beginning of 3 human life in the health curriculum for public school students. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows: 6 7 Each school district that offers kindergarten through (a) grade 12 shall offer, as a required curriculum: 8 a foundation curriculum that includes: 9 (1)English language arts; 10 (A) 11 (B) mathematics; 12 (C) science; and 13 social studies, consisting of Texas, United (D) 14 States, and world history, government, economics, with emphasis on the free enterprise system and its benefits, and geography; and 15 an enrichment curriculum that includes: 16 (2) (A) to the extent possible, languages other than 17 English; 18 health, with emphasis on: 19 (B) 20 (i) physical health, including the 21 importance of proper nutrition and exercise; 22 (ii) mental health, including instruction about mental health conditions, substance abuse, skills to manage 23 24 emotions, establishing and maintaining positive relationships, and

1 responsible decision-making; [and] 2 (iii) suicide prevention, including recognizing suicide-related risk factors and warning signs; and 3 4 (iv) instruction that human life begins at 5 conception and has inherent dignity and immeasurable worth from the 6 moment of conception; physical education; 7 (C) 8 (D) fine arts; career and technology education; 9 (E) 10 (F) technology applications; religious literature, including the Hebrew 11 (G) Scriptures (Old Testament) and New Testament, and its impact on 12 history and literature; and 13 personal financial literacy. 14 (H) 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026 16 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 21
