## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the small and mid-sized district allotment under the
- 3 public school finance system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 48.101(b), (c), and (d), Education
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A school district that has fewer than 1,600 students in
- 8 average daily attendance is entitled to an annual allotment for
- 9 each student in average daily attendance based on the following
- 10 formula:
- 11  $AA = ((1,600 ADA) \times .0008 [.0004]) \times BA$
- 12 (c) A school district that offers a kindergarten through
- 13 grade 12 program and has less than 5,000 students in average daily
- 14 attendance is entitled to an annual allotment for each student in
- 15 average daily attendance based on the formula, of the following
- 16 formulas, that results in the greatest annual allotment:
- 17 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), if the district is
- 18 eligible for that formula; or
- 19 (2)  $AA = ((5,000 ADA) \times .00005 [.000025]) \times BA.$
- 20 (d) Instead of the allotment under Subsection (b) or (c)(1),
- 21 a school district that has fewer than 300 students in average daily
- 22 attendance and is the only school district located in and operating
- 23 in a county is entitled to an annual allotment for each student in
- 24 average daily attendance based on the following formula:

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
