- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 27.0513(d), Water Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) Notwithstanding Sections 5.551, 5.556, 27.011, and
- 8 27.018, an application for an authorization or an amendment to an
- 9 authorization that allows the permit holder to conduct mining and
- 10 restoration activities in production zones within the boundary
- 11 established in the permit is an uncontested matter not subject to a
- 12 contested case hearing or the hearing requirements of Chapter 2001,
- 13 Government Code, if:
- 14 (1) the authorization is for a production zone located
- 15 within the boundary of a permit that incorporates, for each
- 16 production zone addressed in the application, a range table of
- 17 groundwater quality restoration values used to measure groundwater
- 18 restoration by the commission;
- 19 (2) the application includes, for each production zone
- 20 <u>addressed in the application</u>, groundwater quality restoration
- 21 values falling at or below the upper limit of the range established
- 22 in Subdivision (1); and
- 23 (3) the authorization is for a production zone located
- 24 within the boundary of a permit that incorporates groundwater

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- 1 baseline characteristics of the wells for the application required
- 2 by commission rule.
- 3 SECTION 2. Sections 27.0513(f) and (g), Water Code, are
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an application for an authorization or an amendment to an
- 7 authorization that is submitted to the Texas Commission on
- 8 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An application for an authorization or an amendment to an
- 10 authorization that was submitted to the commission before the
- 11 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the
- 12 time the application or amendment was submitted, and the former law
- 13 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
