14	orientation or gender identity to students enrolled in
15	prekindergarten through 12th grade.
16	(b) This section may not be construed to limit:
17	(1) a student's ability to engage in speech or
18	expressive conduct protected by the First Amendment to the United
19	States Constitution or by Section 8, Article I, Texas Constitution,
20	that does not result in material disruption to school activities;

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
