9	(1) "Day-care center" has the meaning assigned by
10	Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
11	(2) "Public property" includes a street, highway,
12	alley, public park, or sidewalk.
13	(3) "School" means a private or public elementary or

15	(4) "School or day-care center property" means:
16	(A) all land and buildings owned or leased by a

18	(B) any grounds or buildings on which an activity

20	(b) A person commits an offense if the person:

2	(A) a reason or relationship for entering or
3	remaining on the property that involves custody of or

6	(B) written permission from an authorized

8	(3) receives a reasonable request to depart by an
9	administrator, educator, or security personnel officer employed by

11	(4) fails to depart.
12	(c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
13	(d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
14	also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
