- SECTION 2. Section 21.165(a)(1), Penal Code, is amended to

- 12 (1) "Deep fake $\underline{image or}$ video" means $\underline{an image or}$ [\underline{a}]
- 13 video, created with the intent to deceive, that appears to depict a
- 14 real person performing an action that did not occur in reality.
- SECTION 3. Sections 21.165(b) and (c), Penal Code, are
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (b) A person commits an offense if, without the effective
- 18 consent of the person appearing to be depicted, the person
- 19 knowingly produces or distributes by electronic means a deep fake
- 20 <u>image or</u> video that appears to depict the person with the person's
- 21 intimate parts exposed or engaged in sexual conduct.
- (c) An offense under this section is a state jail felony
- 23 [Class A misdemeanor].
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 4 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 6 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 7 before that date.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
